## **2017 World Angus Forum - Youth Program**

*Awarded by the Canadian Angus Foundation*

*The Canadian Angus Foundation functions to preserve and expand the Angus breed for future generations through education, youth development, scientific and market research, and historical preservation and restoration. The Canadian Angus Foundation was incorporated in 1993 and is the charitable arm of the Canadian Angus Association.*

The 2017 Forum youth program will consist of registration day on June 21, a trip to the Royal Highland Show, stock judging, attendance at the Forum Conference, agri-skills and activities, farm visits, tours with the WAF delegates, a visit to Scotbeef and the competition finale on July 2 (schedule subject to change).

Individuals will be chosen to represent Canada in teams of four. Each individual chosen will be required to pay a \$1000 non-refundable deposit plus any incidental expenses during the trip. **To be considered for the award, complete and submit application to the Canadian Angus Foundation no later than January 15, 2017.**

### **Requirements for Entry:**

- Teams must be of mixed gender, therefore, the selection process will take this into consideration.
- Participants are to be between 18 and 25 years old as of July 1, 2017.
- Team members must be available June 20 - July 3, 2017 for travel and the contest. If you wish to travel outside of those dates, contact Belinda Wagner.
- Those team members selected will be required to pay \$1000. Participants will incur personal spending expenses.
- Competition rules are subject to change.

### **How to apply:**

1. All applications must be typed. No hand-written applications will be accepted.
2. Cover sheet with name, contact information and CAA member ID # must be included.
3. Resume to include but not limited to Canadian Junior Angus involvement, community activities, school involvement and leadership activities.
4. Submit a 500 word essay on what you hope to accomplish if selected to represent Canada at this competition.
5. Applications must be submitted by e-mail only to Executive Director Belinda Wagner at [bwagner@cdnangus.ca](mailto:bwagner@cdnangus.ca) with the subject line reading "WAF Youth Program Applicant".
6. All considered candidates may be contacted for a Skype interview prior to selection.
7. A selection committee will have results not later than February 18, 2017 with teams announced at the 2017 GOAL Conference in Edmonton, AB.

*\*\*The previous World Angus Forum Youth Team participants are not eligible to apply.*
